And it further appearing to the Court that there is on file in this Court a written waiver of service of said order to show cause and consent in writing of the next of kin of said minors, and all persons interested in said estate that said sale be made;

And it appearing to the Court that on the 30th day of April 1908 no person or persons appeared to show cause why said sale should not be made, and that no cause appeared why said sale should not be made;

And it further appearing to the Court that on the 11th day of May 1908, the Court made an order directing said guardian to sell all said minors' interests in and to the said within described property at Public auction at the front door of the building in which the County Court was then sitting, at 9 o'clock A.M. on the 6th day of June 1908;

And it further appearing from the affidavit of Fred C. Johannes publisher of the Weekly Sapulpa Democrat, a newspaper having a general circulation in Creek County, State of Oklahoma that notice of said sale was given by four consecutive weekly publications in said Weekly Sapulpa Democrat, the first of said publications having been made on the 14th day of May 1908, and the last of said publications having been made on the 4th day of June 1908;

And it further appearing from the affidavit of Thomas D. Lyons that notice of said sale was given for more than three weeks before June 6th., 1908 by posting notices in three of the most public places in Creek County, State of Oklahoma, and three of the most public places in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma;

And it further appearing to the Court that on the 6th day of June 1908, at 9 o'clock A.M. at the front door of the building in which the County Court was then sitting, said W.P. Moore sold all the said minors' in and to the within described property at public auction, and that said property was sold there and there to Roy Hoffman for the sum of \$495.

That on June 11th 1908 said guardian filed his return of said sale in this Court, and that on said date the Court made an order setting the 24th day of June 1908 for the hearing of said return;

And it further appearing from the affidavit of William Stryker publisher of the Tulsa Daily Democrat that notice of said hearing was published for ten consecutive days prior to June 24th 1908 in the Tulsa Daily Democrat a newspaper having a general circulation in Tulsa County;
