

The party of the second part shall have the right at any time to remove all machinery, and fixtures placed on said premises, including the right to draw and remove casing.

If the first well drilled on said premises produces fifty barrels of oil every twenty four hours after thirty days, then lessee shall pay to lessor an additional sum of Seventeen (\$17.00) Dollars pper acre within sixty days from bringing in said well.

The party of the second part, its heirs, successors or assigns, shall have the right at any time on the payment of One (\$1.00) Dollar and all payable obligations then due to the party of the first part, his heirs or assigns, to surrender this lease for cancellation after which all payments and liabilities thereafter to accrue under and by virtue of its terms shall cease and determine.

All covenants and agreements herein set forth between the parties heretofore shall extend to their successors, heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.
