WITNESSETH That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the rents, covenants and agreements of the said party of the second part, hereinafter set forth do by these presents demise, lease and rent to the said party of the second part, the following described property, situated in the County of Tulsa State of Oklahoma to-wit:

The North west quarter of the South west quarter Section Twenty Nine (29) Township nineteen North (19) and range Twelve (12) east containing forty acres more or less being his home *ad*.

To have and to hold the same unto the said party of the first part from the Fourteenth day of July 1908, to the Fourteenth day of July 1913.

And the said party of the second part in consideration of the leasing of the premises, as above set forth, covenants and agrees with the said party of the first part to pay the said party of the first part his, heirs or assigns, as rent for the same the total amount or sum of Ten Dollars per year payable annually.
