## --: Order of Confirmation :--

It appearing to the Court at a hearing on this 20th day of July 1908, that on the 7th day of July 1908 Emily M Campbell, executrix in the above entitled cause, filed her petition in this Court praying for the confirmation of the sale of the land herein described; and

It further appearing to the Court that on the said 7th day of July 1908, the Court made an order setting the 20th day of July 1908 for the hearing of said petition and in said order required the publication of a notice of said hearing for a period of ten days previous to the said 20th day of July 1908; and,

It is further appearing to the Court that under the terms of the will of the above named decedent, the said will having been admitted to probate in this Court on the 10th day of December the executrix Emily M Campbell the petitioner aforesaid, was authorized and empowered to sell and dispose of any and all real estate of said decedent as to her seemed fit and proper; and,

It further appearing to the Court that in accordance with said power and authority given in said will the said executrix Emily M Campbell sold to Al Brown Lot Seventeen (17) in block (4) of the T T T Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the sum of \$ 250.00 and

It further appearing to the Court that no special mode of sale was required by said will of said decedent, and that said sale was legally made and fairly conducted; that the sum paid was more than 90% of the appraised value of said lot, and that no greater sum than above specified could be obtained; and,

It further appearing to the Court that the said executrix filed her return of said proceedings of said sale on the said 7th day of July 1908 as stated herein and

It further having been proved to the satisfaction of this Court that pursuant to the order of this Court made on the 7th day of July and the Statutes of Oklahoma in such cases made and provided, there was published in the Tulsa Daily World, a new paper published daily in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, for a period of ten days before the said 20th day of July 1908, a notice that the executrix would, on the said 20th day of July 1908 apply for the confirmation of the said sale of the said property herein described; and
