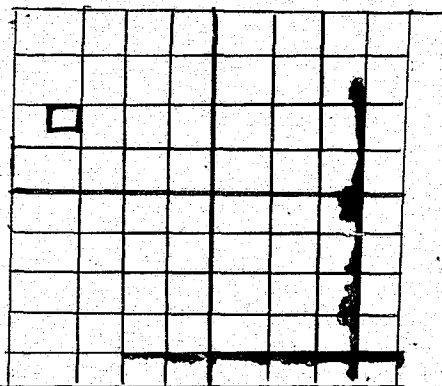

LEASE .

Now this 21st day of July 1908 the petition of Elmer L Collins as  
guardian of the person and estate of Evelin Gazelle Collins, a minor, coming on to be  
heard and it appearing to the court that the said guardian on the 21st day of July 1908 , under  
the general order of the Court relative to the leasing of lands of minors for oil and gas  
mining purposes made, executed and delivered an oil and gas mining lease to the Olive Oil  
Company of Tulsa Oklahoma, covering the following described lands of the said minor ward, to  
wit :-

The NE /4 of the SE/4 of the NE/4 and the SW/4 of the NE/4 of the NE/ 4 of  
Section Thirty (30) Township Twenty -One (21) North, Range Thirteen (13) East; containing  
twenty (20) acres, more or less .

And it further appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the *sum*  
paid for said lease as a bonus is not disproportionate to the value of the property and  
that it is fully adequate; and it further appearing to the Court that the lessee in said  
lease agrees to pay to the said guardian one-eighth (1/8) royalty on all oil produced and  
saved from the premises and that in case gas is found to pay to said guardian one hundred  
Fifty (\$ 150.00) Dollars per year for each gas well where gas is sold off the premises, all
