This Agreement, made and entered into this 29 day of July 1908 by and between lillie Grayson, of Mounds Okla, party of the first part and W.E. Spriggs of Fry Oklahora party of the second part .

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements thereinafter mentioned by the party of the second part, the party of the first part this day and by these presents do demise and let to the party of the second part his heirs and assigns for agricultural purposes, for the term of Four Years from the first day of February 1909 the following described parcels of land :

The north one half of the North east quarter of section One Township seventeen North Range Thirsteen East .

It is understood and agreed that the party of the second part shall pay said party of the first part as rental one third of all grain said grain to be cribbed on the place .

Also the East one half of the south west quarter of section Thirty Six Township eighteen North Range Thirteon East .

For the last described land the party of the second part to pay party of the first part a rental of Three Hundred and Fifty Dollars in cash receipt of Which is hereby acknowledged .

It is further agreed that the expense of any and all improvements necessary to be made on any of the above described land shall be paid by the party of the first part .
