ORDER APPROVING DEED.

On this 27 day of July 1908 comes on for hearing the petition of Rachel Christie , Nancy Flute and S.R. Lewis for an order and decree of this Court approving the sale and conveyance of the said Rachel Christie and Nancy Flute, full-blood Indian heirs, to the said S.R. Lewis of Certain lands allotted to the said Mary Christie , deceased . And the Court having seen said petition and heard the testimony of the petitioners herein, as to the matters set forth in said petition and as to the character and value of the land sought to be conveyed, doth find as follows :-

That the said Mary Christie departed this life intestate and without issue on or about the 15th day of June 1904, being at the date of her death of the age of seven years; that at the date of her death said decedent resided with her parent near the town of Hulbert in the Northern District of the Indian Territory, in what is now a part of the Cherokee County, State of Oklahoma; that said Mary Christie was a citizen of the Cherokee tribe of Indians duly enrolled by the Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes as a full blood Indian ; that there was selected for and allotted to said Mary Christie as and for her share of the lands of the Cherokee Nation the following described tract of land, to-wit :

West one half of the South-east quarter of the South-east quarter and the North One-half of the South-east quarter of the south-east quarter of section Twenty-nine (29) Township Twenty -two (22) North, Range Thirteen (13) East containing 140 acres, more or less , and lying and being situated in Tulsa County State of Oklahoma .

That the said Mary Christie at the date of her death left her surviving as her sole and only heirs at law the following persons, to-wit : Rachel Christie , her mother, and Nancy Flute sister of the half blood of the said Rachel Christie, being petitioners herein . Both the said Rachel Christie and the said Nancy Flute are duly enrolled-citizens of the Cherokee Nation or tribe of Indians , enrolled by the Commission to the five Civilized Tribes as full-bloods; that said Rachel Christie, and Nancy Flute, sole and only heirs at law of the said Mary Christie, deceased, have sold all their interest in and to the tract of land allotted to said Mary Christie as hereinbefore described, to S.R. Lewis of Tulsa Oklahoma, for the price and sum of \$ 560.00 that they have executed to said S.R. Lewis a conveyance therefor in the form of a general warranty deed bearing date of July 27 1908 , and duly acknowledged as provided by law, conveying to said S.R. Lewis the fee simple title to the aforesaid tract of land .

The Court further finds that this court has jurisdiction of the settlement of the estate of the said Mary Christie, deceased allottee aforesaid;
