that no administration was ever had on her said estate; that said deceased left no debts, a that all the funeral expenses and expenses of the last sickness have long since been fully paid; that said deceased allottee left no property other than her allottment hereinbefore described .

The court further finds that the aforesaid tract of land is unimproved grass land, that the entire tract is rough and broken and not fit for cultivation; that the said price of \$ 560.00 conside rtion in the conveyance aforesaid; is the fair and reasonalhe value of said tract of land; that said consideration has been fully paid to the said Rachel Christie and Mancy Flute , and that said deed and conveyance should be approved .

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED? ADJUDGED AND DECREED, by this Court that said deed from the said Rachel Christie and Nancy Flute to the said S.R.Lewis bearing date of July 27 1908 conveying the land hereinbefore dewscribed to the said S.R.Lewis, for the consideration of \$ 560.00 be and the same is hereby approved and confirmed as binding and effectual on all parties thereto .
