Transferable only with consent of the Secretary of the Interior.

This indenture made and entered into in quadruplicate on this 31st day of July A D 1908 by and between Runabout Wilson of Hulbert Okla party of the first part and C.L.Brown of Tulsa Okla party of the second part, under and in accordance with the provisions of existing law and the rules and regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior relative to grazing leases in the Cherokee Nation, Oklahoma.
