It is further understood and agreed by the parties hereto that no sublease or transfer of this lease, or of any interest therein or thereunder, can be directly or indirectly made without the consent and approval of the Secretary of the Interior, and that namy such assignment or Transfer made or attempted witout such consent and approval shall be void .

The covenants herein contained shall extend and be binding upon the heirs executors, administrators, successors, or assigns of the parties to this lease and this lease shall be subject to all rules and regulations lawfully prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior, or which may be hereafter so prescribed by him.

The party of the second part hereby acknowledge himself firmly bound for the faithful performance of the stipulatons of this indenture of lease by and under the bond made and executed by the party of the second part as principal and as suret entered into the day of and which shall remain on file in the Indian Office ...

It is expressly understood and agreed by the parties hereto that if the Secretary of the Interior is at any time satisfied that any of the covenant contained herein or that any of the provisions of any regulations heretofore or that may hereafter be lawfully preschibed by him, have been or are being violated, he may cancel this lease and that his declaration of cancellation shall be effective without resreting to the court and without further proceedings; and that the lessor shall then be entitled to the immediate possession of the land .
