ORDER APPROVING DEED.

COMPALED

On this 6th day of August 1908 comes on for hearing of petition of Tobe and Mary Partridge and Charles Page for an order and judgment of this Court, approving sale and conveyance of the interest of the petitioners herein as aforesaid heirs of Alice Partridge deceased, to Charles Page for all their interest in the allotment of said Alice Partridge deceased.

And the Court having heard the testimony of the petitioners herein and also of Tom Jones, Reuben L. Partridge and Peter Grayson residents of the County of Tulsa & Creek and State of Oklahoma, as to the character of ^{and} the value of land conveyed and as to the other matters set forth in said petition, doth find as follows:

That one Alice Partridge deceased, departed on the 6 day of August 1899 near the town of Tulsa in that part of the Indian Territory which is now part of Tulsa County and State of Oklahoma; that said Alice Partridge was a citizen of the Creek Nation of Tribe of Indians ^{duly} ~~and~~ enrolled by the Commissioner to the Five Civilized Tribes as a full blood Indian said allottee's name appearing upon the approved roll of Creek Indians opposite No. 6421 That there was selected for and allotted to the said Alice Partridge as and for her share of the land of the Creek Nation the following described land to-wit:

The south half of Southeast quarter of Section Five in Township Nineteen, North Range Twelve East in Tulsa County - State of Oklahoma and the East One Half of South East quarter of Section Two in Township Eighteen North range Ten East.

And lying in and being situated in the County of Creek State of Oklahoma.

That said Alice Partridge at the date of her death left surviving heirs as follows her sole and only heirs at law the following persons to-wit: Tobe Partridge father and ^{Mary} ~~May~~ Partridge mother that the above named heirs of the said Alice Partridge deceased are duly enrolled citizens of the Creek Nation of Tribe of Indians; that the restrictions
