

uph the alienation of inherited lands of the Allottees of the Creek Nation were removed by an act of Congress entitled "An act for the removal <sup>for</sup> the restrictions from part of the lands of the allottees of the Five Civilized Tribes" and approved May 27th 1908. And that said act provided among other things that no conveyance of any interest of any full blood heir in such land shall be valid unless approved by the Court having jurisdiction over the estate of the deceased allottee. That at the date of the <sup>death</sup> death of the said Alice Partridge deceased allottee of the aforesaid she was a resident for that part of the Indian Territory now included in the limits of Tulsa County State of Oklahoma, and that the County Court of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma is the Court having jurisdiction of the <sup>settlement</sup> allotment of the estate of said Alice Partridge deceased allottee aforesaid, and that no administration was had upon said estate; that said deceased left no debts and that all the funeral expenses and expenses of last sickness have long since been fully paid, and that said deceased left no property other than the allotment above described and that the said Tobe Partridge and Mary Partridge heirs at law of the said Alice Partridge deceased have sold all their interest in the tract of land allotted to said deceased as herein described to Charles Page of Tulsa Oklahoma for the price and sum of \$ 1500.00 and that they have executed to said Charles Page a conveyance thereof, in form of a warranty deed, conveying to the said Charles Page the fee simple title in and to the aforesaid tract of land; that the said sum of \$ 1500.00 <sup>sale</sup> consideration for such land is the fair and reasonable value of said tract of land, and has been fully paid by the said Charles Page to petitioners herein grantors in the said deed; and that <sup>said deed</sup> the conveyance should be approved.

It is <sup>therefore</sup> further ordered and adjudged by the Court that the conveyance so executed by said Tobe and Mary Partridge as aforesaid to the said Charles Page, for the consideration of \$ 1500.00 bearing date of 4th day of August 1908 be and the same is hereby approved and conveyance as valid and binding on all parts thereto.
