KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

Whereas, William A Stuart of Skiatook Indian Territory, is the lessee of a certain oil and gas mining lease executed in his favor by Frank Phillips guardian of Ula Maud Phillips, Arminor, a citizen of the Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory in accordance with the rules and regulations laid down and prescribed by the Honorable Secretary of the Interior, said lease being executed on the 2nd day of June 1905, for a period of Fifteen years, and covering the allotment of said Cherokee Citizen, described as follows :-

North One -Half of southwest quarter of Northwest quarter;  
Northwest quarter of southeast quarter of Northwest quarter  
West 10.15 acres of Lot three ;  
South 20 acres of Lot four.  
Northwest quarter of southwest quarter of southwest quarter, all in

section 1 Township 21 N Range 12 E and Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section 8 Township 10 N Range 19 E and containing 80.15 acres more or less, and

Whereas, the said William A Stuart has heretofore obtained permission of the Honorable Secretary of the Interior to make a transfer and assignment of said oil and gas mining lease to the Stuart Oil Company, of Bartlesville, Indian Territory, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws in force in the Indian Territory.
