

to and from the place of operation or drilling and the right to lay pipes lines for the purpose of conveying or conducting water, steam, gas or oil over and across said premises and also the right to remove at any time any and all machinery, oil well supplies or appurtenances of any kind belonging to said second party.

The said party of the second part agrees to commence one well within nine (9) months from the date hereof (unavoidable accidents and delays excepted) and in case of failure to commence one well within such time, the party of the second part hereby agrees that this lease shall be null and void at the option of the lessor.

It is understood by and between the parties hereto that the terms of this lease shall extend and be binding upon their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns.

And I, wife of said lessor in consideration of the foregoing promises, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part, all my right of dower and homestead in and to the above described premises for the purposes of the foregoing lease.
