I 908 the Court made and order setting the I4th day of August I 908 for the hearing of said peltiton, and in said order required the publication of a notice of said hearing fo a period of ten days previous to hthe said I4th day of August I 908, andk

It further a ppe aring to the Court that under the terms of the will of the above named decedent the will having been admitted to probate in this Court on the IOth day of December 1907 the executriz, Emily M Campbell, the peititoner aforenamed, was authorized and empowered to sell and dispose of any and all of the real estate of said decendent as to her seemed fit and proper, and,

It further appearing to the Court that in accordance with said power and authority given in said will, the said executorix, Emily M Campbell, sold to Jospehine B Robbins lots One (I) and To (2) in Block One (I) of George B Perryman . Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklaho am, for the sum of \$ IIOO.00; and,

It further appearing to the court that no special mode of sale was required by said will of the said decedent, and that said sale was legally made and fairly conducted; that the sum paid was more than 90% of the appraised value of said lots and that no greater sum than above specified could be obtained; and,

It further appearing to the Court that the said executrix filed he her return f said proceedings of said sale on the said Ist day of August as stated herein and;

It further having been proved to the sattsfaction of this Court to that pursuant to the order of this Court made on the Ist day of Agust 1908, and the statutes of Oklahoma in such ca es made and provided, there was publishedd in the Tulsa Daily World, a newspaper published daily in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma for a period of ten days before the said I4th day of August 1908, a notice that the executrix would on the said I4th day of August 1908, apply for the confirmation of the said sale of the said property herein described; and,

It further having been proved to the satisfaction of this Court he that the said notice properly described the lands herein mentioned, propertly stated the price for which the same was sold, and i in all ways conformed to the order of this Court and the Statutes of Oklahoma, and,

It further having been proved to the satisfactic n of this Court by the affidavit of Chas E Dent, publisher of the Tulsa Daily World, that the said notice was published the time required by the said order and Statute; and,

"It further appearing to the court that the said sale has been made in conformity to the provisions of the statutes in such cases made and provided; and

NOW on motion of Martin & Rice attorneys for executrix, it is order and adjudged that the petition be and hereby is granted and the sale and the return of the proceedings hereof be and the same are hereby in all things approved and confirmed, and the Clerk of this Court is ordered and directed to make an entry on the journal of this Court, that the Court is satisfied with the legality of this sale, a d said Clerk is ordered to record a certifie d copy of this order in the office of the Register of Deeds in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executix make, execute and deliver to the said purcha er a good and sifficient deed of conveyance to the property so sold, conveyang all of the right, title and interest of the said decedent in and to said property

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
