THE MUSKOGEE (CREEK) NATION . INDIAN TERRITORY .

To all to whom these presents shall come greeting :

Whereas, a townsite commission heretofore appointed and acting under authority of the Act of Congress approved March 1 1901 (31 Stat 861) agreement by the Creek Nation May 25 1901 has been appraised the lots in the town of Red Fork Muskogee Creek Nation Indian Territory; and

WHEREAS, the plat of said town was approved by the Secretary of the Interior on the 20th day of February 1902 and was duly placed on file and,

WHEREAS, said commission has appraised all of the town lots included in said plat at their true value, excluding improvements, which appraisal has been approved by the Secretary of the Interior; and ,

WHEREAS, the said commission has awarded the real estate heretofore to Calvin W Barnett who has paid Fifty-five (\$55.00) Dollars the full amount of the purchase price into the treasury of the United States to the Credit of the Muskogee Creek Nation of Indians with the United States agent at Muskogee Indian Territory, and is, therefore entitled to a patent .

NOW THEREFORE, I , the undersigned the Principal Chief of the Muskogee (CREEK) Nation do, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the aforesaid Act of Congress of the United States, hereby grant sell and convey unto the said Calvin W Barnett his heirs, and assigns forever, all the right, title and interest of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation , aforesaid, in and to Lot Numbered 1 in Block numbered 41 in the town of Red Fork , Muskogee (Creek) Nation Indian Territory, and according to the plat thereof on file as aforesaid .

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the principal Chief of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation have herunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of said Nation to be affixed at the date hereinafter shown .
