That the said Pamela Bruner mother of said deceased Josephine Co achman is duly enrolled full-blood citizen of the Creek Nation of Indian and resides in Tulsa County State of Oklahoma, that on the death of Said Josephine Coachman the said Pamela Bruner inherited a life estate inand to said lands that on the 6th day of August 1908 the said Pamela Bruner executed and acknowledged a deed in favor of D.D. Wamsley of Bixby Oklahoma, wher in she granted bargailed and sold all her interest inand to the said land to the said D.D. Wamsley in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00)

It is therefore considered, prdered and adjuydged that the seld conveyance of august 6th I908 made by the said Pamela Bruner to the said D.D.Wamsley conveying her interest in said land be and the same is hereby approved.
