

matter and being fully advised in the premises, finds that said land was allotted to one Josephine Coachman and allotment deeds issued to said Josephine Coachman for said land on the 18th day of November 1902 and approved by the Department of the Interior January 15th 1903 and that the said Josephine Coachman died intestate on the 9 day of November 1907 leaving no children nor descendants of children, nor no father, but leaving as her sole heirs at law her mother Pamela Bruner and Benjamin Bruner her brother, Maybell Bruner her sister, Minnie Bruner her sister and Archie Bruner her brother.

That the said Pamela Bruner mother of said deceased Josephine Coachman is duly enrolled full-blood citizen of the Creek Nation of Indians and resides in Tulsa County State of Oklahoma, that on the death of said Josephine Coachman the said Pamela Bruner inherited a life estate in and to said lands that on the 6th day of August 1908 the said Pamela Bruner executed and acknowledged a deed in favor of D.D. Wamsley of Bixby Oklahoma, where in she granted bargained and sold all her interest in and to the said land to the said D.D. Wamsley in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00)

The Court further finds that said sum of One Thousand Dollars is a reasonable price for the life estate interest of the said Pamela Bruner she being 36 years of age; that the said Pamela Bruner is the owner of one Hundred and sixty acres of land in addition to said ~~allotted~~ interest in the above described lands, which are unimproved and not in cultivation and that she is unable at present to either improve or put her said lands in cultivation and that it is to the best interests of the said Pamela Bruner to sell her interest in the land of the said Josephine Coachman in order to enable her to improve her own lands.

It is therefore considered, ordered and adjudged that the said conveyance of August 6th 1908 made by the said Pamela Bruner to the said D.D. Wamsley conveying her interest in said land be and the same is hereby approved.
