Order confirming Lease.

On this 25th day of August 1908 comes on for hearing the report of said Guardian of the execution of a lease for oil and gas mining purposes on the allotment of said minor.

And it appearing to the court upon examination of said report of leasing and from the testimony of the guardian had in open court that said leasing was duly, properly and legally done according to the order of court. And it further appearing to the court that said Guardian has executed to the Homeland Oil Company as oil and gas mining lease covering the lands of said ward, described as follows :
 to-wit : SW 1/4 of SW 1/4; NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of SW 1/4; S 1/2 of NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 ; and NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec 21 Twp 20 N Range 13 E.
