

of the purchase price into the treasury of the United States to the Credit of the Muskogee or Creek Nation of Indians with the United States Indian Agent at Muskogee Indian Territory and is, therefore, entitled to a patent;

Now, therefore, I the undersigned, the Principal Chief of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation, do, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the aforesaid Act of Congress of the United States, hereby grant, sell and convey unto said Theophile Meerchaert Bishop Trustee of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Oklahoma, successors and assigns forever, all the right, title and interest of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation aforesaid, in and to Lots Numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 in Block Numbered 115 in the town of Tulsa Muskogee (Creek) Nation, Indian Territory and according to the plat thereof on file as aforesaid.

In witness whereof, I, the Principal Chief of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation, have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of said Nation to be affixed at the date hereinafter shown.

-----ORDER APPROVING DEED:-----

In the matter of the Estate of
Lena Jefferson, Deceased.

Now, on this 26th day of August 1908 is presented to this Court the petition of Mose Jefferson heretofore filed herein, praying the Court to approve the deed of conveyance dated August 26th 1908 and duly acknowledged and conveying to John W Mc Illroy at and for the cash price and consideration of Nine Hundred Dollars, all the right, title interest and estate of the said Mose Jefferson as heir at law of Lena Jefferson, deceased, in and to the following described lands to-wit:

The East half (E 1/2) of the Southwest quarter (SW 1/4) and lots three (3) and Four (4) of section Eighteen (18) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, containing in all about One Hundred and fifty three and 20/100 (153 - 20/100) Acres of land.
