Now, therefore, I the undersigned, the Principal Chief of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation, do, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the aforesaid Act of Congress of the United States, hereby grant, sell and convey unto said Theopile Meerchaeart Bishop Trustee of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Oklahoma, successors and assigns forever, all the right, title and interest of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation aforesaid, in and to Lots Numbered I,2,3,4,5 and 6 in Block Numbered II5 in the town of Tulsa Muskogee (CReek) Nation, Indian Territory and according to the Mat thereof on file as aforesaid.
