

Indians to Lena Jefferson, the mother of the Petitioner Mose Jefferson, that the said Lena Jefferson departed this life on the 9th day of January 1907; that the said Mose Jefferson as one of the three surviving heirs and children of said Lena Jefferson, deceased, inherited an undivided one third interest in said above described land. That the said sum of Nine Hundred dollars is a fair price and consideration for the interest and estate of said Mose Jefferson in and to said lands, and that the deed of Mose Jefferson now exhibited in Court and conveying said interest in and to said lands to John W Mc Illroy ought to be approved.

And the court having examined the said Mose Jefferson thoroughly relative to the sale of his said interest in said land to said John W Mc Illroy and said Mose Jefferson having testified that he was fully satisfied with said sale and that said price of Nine Hundred Dollars cash offered by said John W Mc Illroy was the best price obtainable, after having made numerous efforts to obtain a better price; and that said Mose Jefferson when so examined by the Court understood thoroughly all of the details of said transaction and sale, and that at the time he was so examined by the Court thoroughly sober.

It is therefore, by the Court considered, ordered and adjudged that the said warranty deed executed by the said Mose Jefferson on the 26th day of August 1908 and conveying to the said John W Mc Illroy all the right title and interest and estate inherited by the said Mose Jefferson in and to the above described lands, be and the same is hereby in all things confirmed, ratified and approved and that the said John W Mc Illroy pay all costs of this proceedings.
