

State of Oklahoma in chambers at the District Court House in the City of Muskogee, Third Judicial District, State of Oklahoma, on this the 8th day of August 1908 for the adjudication of the question of alimony arising in said cause of action, and the plaintiff being present in person and by attorney and the defendant being represented by his Attorney of record R.C. Allen Esq. and after hearing the evidence introduced and the Court being fully advised as to the existing property rights of the parties to this action finds that the Plaintiff is entitled to have and recover from the defendant Alvin H Orcutt, the sum of Six Hundred Dollars as alimony, and;

It is therefore, ordered decreed and adjudged that the plaintiff Hattie Orcutt by F.N. Moore, her father and next friend have and recover from the defendant Alvin H Orcutt the sum of Six Hundred Dollars and the costs of ~~the~~ ^{this} action and that execution issue therefor and that the writ of injunction issued in said above cause direct to the defendant restraining him from conveying or in any manner encumbering certain lands therein described shall remain in full force and effect until this judgment shall have been complied with.

To the entering of this decree the defendant excepts and filed a motion for a new trial which is overruled and defendant prays as appeal which is allowed and sixty days given with which to prepare and file case made and plaintiff given 10 days thereafter to suggest amendments and objection and 5 days thereafter to settle same.

Execution to be stayed upon giving appeal bond of \$ 1000.00 provided in divorce decree. Execution to issue after 15 days from this date unless appeal bond is given.
