Whereas, it further it further appearing that on said day, to-wit, the 7th day of September the date set for the hearing of the petition to sell said lands, the father of the saud Ward, George B Mon tgomery, was present in person, and the said Curator, John F War ren was present in person, and that the matters and things set out in said petition were regularly heard by the Court and the Court, upon due examination and consideration of said petition and after a fall hearing upon the same, and after due examination of the proofs and allegations of the parties interested, found that a sale of the real estate set out in the petition was necessary and for the best interests of the said estate and all concerned; and
