Now, on this 26th day of August A.D.1908 the petition of Eli Ellis and Eliza Ellis coming on to be heard, praying for an order approving the sale of real estate described in said petition, to Amos W Lord, Huquette F Aby and William F Tucker .

And it appearing to the Court upon satisfactory proof, that Eli Ellis and Eliza Ellis are heirs at law of Nancy Ellis deceased, and have a right to sell the same under the provisions of an Act of Congress, Public No 140 approved May 27 1908 and that the price was fair and reasonable, said matter being submitted to the Court, and upon due examination and consideration of said petition, and after a full hearing upon the same and upon due consideration of the proofs offered in the matter, the Court finds that the sale of the land of the said Nancy Ellis , deceased, by Eli Ellis and Eliza Ellis, heirs of the said decedent to Amos W Lord, Huquette F Aby and William F Tucker on the 3rd day of August 1908 covering the following described lands, to-wit :

Northwest quarter (1/4) of the southeast quarter (1/4) and Northeast quarter (1/4) of the southwest quarter (1/4) of Section Seven (7) Township Twenty -One (21) North Range Thirteen (13) East for the best interest of the said Eli Ellis and Eliza Ellis .

It is therefore ordered , adjudged and decreed by the Court that the said sale be and the same is hereby ratified and confirmed and the deed as made by Eli Ellis and Eliza Ellis to Amos W Lord, Huquette F Aby, and William F Tucker covering the lands above described, be and the same is hereby approved .
