ORDER CONFIRMING LEASE FOR OIL AND GAS MINING PURPOSES .

On this 21st day of September 1908 comes on for hearing the return of sale of certain real estate for oil and gas mining purposes made by James Arrowood as guardian of the estate of Roy Arrowood, a minor, and said guardian appearing in person and by Lawrence & Lawrence his attorneys, and no objections having been made to said return or to the confirmation thereof, and no exceptions being filed thereto and the Court having examined said return and having heard and considered the evidence of witnesses offered in support thereof, and being fully advised in the premises, finds as follows :-

That in pursuance of an order of sale heretofore entered herein on the 10th day of August 1908 authorizing said Guardian to sell the real estate hereinafter described for oil and gas mining purposes, said guardian did on the 19th day of September 1908 sell the real estate of said minor described as follows, to-wit :-

SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 18 and NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 17, Township 21 N Range 14 E , in Tulsa County Oklahoma, and

W 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 and the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 11 Township 21 N Range 14 E in Rogers County Oklahoma . for oil and gas ^{mining} purposes at Public auction to the Duquesne Oil & Gas Company of Bartlesville Oklahoma for a cash bonus of \$ 50.00 and one-eighth royalty for all oil produced, \$ 150.00 per year for gas producing well, and \$ 1.00 per acre annual rental until well is drilled; that said sale was made after due notice as prescribed by said order of sale; that said purchasers were the highest bidders therefor and said sum the highest and best sum bid; that said sale was legally made and ^{fairly} ~~fairly~~ conducted and managed, and that said guardian in all things proceeded and conducted and managed such sale as required by the statute in such cases made and provided and as by said order of sale required and directed .

And it further appearing to the Court that said guardian has executed to said Duquesne Oil & Gas Company an oil and gas mining lease upon the terms hereinbefore set forth for a term expiring with the minority of said ward and that the lease so executed is the best obtainable by said guardian .
