It appering to the Court at a hearing on this 25th day of September 1908 that on the 12th day of September 1908 , Emily M Campbell, executrix in the above entitled cause, filed her petition in this Court praying for the confirmation of the sale of the land herein described; and,

It further appearing to the Court that on the said 12th day of September 1908 the Court made and order setting the 25th day of September 1908 for the hearing of said petition , and in said order required the publication of a notice of said hearing for a period of ten days previous to the said 25th day of September 1908 ; and
