It is further agreed that the expense of all ordinary repairs incident to maintaining said wall in good and servicable condition shall be borne in equal shares by the said parties, provided, how^ever, that this provision shall not ~~in any way~~ extend to any alterations made by one of the parties hereto for his special benefit or to any repairs made necessary by said alterations.

This contract and the covenants thereof, shall be perpetual and binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns of the parties hereto.
