the free and entire use of the said wall at an equal expense, and subject to the rights of each party.

It is further acreed that the expense of all ordinary repairs incident to maintaining said wall in good and servicable condition shall be borne in equal shares by the said parties, provided, howver, that this provision shall not taxaayxalxxx extend to any alterations made by one of the parties hereto for his special henefit or to an/y repairs made necessary by said alte rations .

This contract and the covenants thereof, shall be perpetual and binding upon the heirs, executor s, adminsitrators and assigns of the parties hereto .
