The Muskogee ( Creek ) Nation, Indian Territory .

To all to whom these presents shall come Greeting :

Whereas, a Townsite commission heretofore appointed and acting under authority of the Act of Congress approved March 1 1901 ( ~~31~~ Stat 861 ) agreements resatified by the Creek Nation May 25 1901 has appraised lots in the Town of Red Fork Muskogee ( Creek ) Nation, Indian Territory; and

WHEREAS, the plat of said town was approved by the Secretary of the Interior on the 20th day of February 1902 and was duly placed on file , and ,

WHEREAS, the said Commission has appraised all of the town lots included in said plat at their true value, excluding improvements, which appraisal has been approved by the Secretary of the Interior; and ,

WHEREAS, the said Commission had awarded the real estate described hereinbelow to David Jackson and Edmond Jackson who has paid One Hundred and Twenty-One & No/100 ( \$ 121.00 ) Dollars the full amount of the purchase price into the treasury of the United State ~~xxxMuskogee~~ to the credit of the Muskogee of Creek Nation of Indians with the United States Indian Agent at Muskogee Indian Territory and is, therefore entitled to a patent ;

NOW THEREFORE, I the undersigned ~~the~~ Principal Chief of the Muskogee ( Creek ) Nation, do, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the aforesaid act of Congress of the United States, hereby grant, sell and convey unto the said David Jackson and Edmond Jackson heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title and interest of the Muskogee ( Creek ) Nation aforesaid in and to the South hHalf of Lot Numbered 4 In Block Numbered 23 ; Lot Numbered 7 in Block numbered 37; Lots numbered 2 and 3 in Block numbered 44 in the Town of Red Fork Muskogee ( Creek ) Nation Indian Territory and according to the plat thereof on file as aforesaid .

In Witness Whereof I , the Principal Chief of the Muskogee ( Creek ) Nation, have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of said nNation to be affixed at the date hereinafter shown .
