-----: DEED OF DEDICATION :-----

Know all men by these presents :-

That we, Annie B Orcutt and S.A. Orcutt, her husband proprietors and owners of the following described property, to-wit :-

All of Lot Three (3) the North 85.5 feet of lot Four (4) North 85.5 feet of the southeast quarter (1/4) of the southwest quarter (1/4) and all the northeast quarter (1/4) of the southwest quarter (1/4) of section seven (7) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East ; also beginning at the southwest corner of the Northwest quarter (1/4) of the southeast quarter (1/4) of Section 7, township 19 N R 13 E and running thence South 85.5 feet, thence east 387.8 feet, thence North 85.5 feet, thence west 387.8 feet to place of beginning ; also beginning at the southwest corner of the Northwest quarter (1/4) of the southeast quarter (1/4) of said section 7 and running thence east 387.8 feet, thence North 865 feet and 10 inches, thence West 24 feet and 7 inches thence north 458 feet and 8 inches to the center line through section 7 Township and Range aforesaid, thence West 370 feet to the center of said section 7, thence south 1324.5 feet to place of beginning all in Tulsa County State of Oklahoma.
