All of the south fast quarter of the Southwest quarter section two of Township Ninetern range Twelve Indian Base & meridian SE 4 SW 4 -2-19-12 containing 40 acres mole less by U.S.Survey, said term of lease to begin on the 1st day of Jan 1908 and to continue one year subject to the co-ditions and restrictions hereinafter specified and set forth.

In consideration of said leasing and renting the said J.A.Pilkington binds himself and promises to pay to the said Mary Partridge as rental for said property, the sum of One Hundred fifteen Dollars, to be paid in cash in advance.

The destruction of the buildings on said premises by fire shall work a ... termination of this lease. The said J.A.Pilkington is no to be hald responsible for any damage done to the contents of said suilding by action of the elements. The said J.A.Pilkinggton agrees to guiet and peaceable #possession of said premises to the said Mary Partridge on the termination of this lease.
