Now to-wit , on this 6th day of October 1908 the above a entitled ^{matter} ~~master~~ came on to be heard before me sitting in regular session of regular term of the above named Court in Probate at the office of said Court in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, on the petition of Jennie Hickory, Tom Hickory and L.L. Lewis for and order and decree of this Court confirming and approving the sale ~~and deed and decree~~ of this Court confirming and approving the sale and conveyance of the said Jennie Hickory and Tom Hickory, full-blood Indian heirs of Moses Coney to the said L.L. Lewis of the undivided one half interest in certain lands allotted by the Creek Nation to said Moses Coney, deceased, to-wit :-

The undivided one half interest (Undivided 1/2) in and to lots One (1) Two (2) and Three (3) in and of the Northwest quarter (NW 1/4) of Section Thirteen (13) Township Nineteen (19) North and range Twelve (12) East containing sixty-five acres more or less as shown by the United States Government survey thereof .

Petitioners Jennie Hickory, Tom Hickory and L.L . Lewis appeared in person and by their attorneys Harvey & Bartlett and Legas Perryman and Henry W Perryman appeared and was duly sworn as interpreters . Jennie Hickory Tom Hickory and L.L Lewis were also duly sworn to testify in the above named proceeding as were also J.D.Jones A.D.Weldy, Thomas Elkins, Wm. Lynch and John R Clark.

After hearing the evidence and being fully advised in the ^{premises} ~~premises~~ as to the matters set forth in the petition and as to the character and value of the land sold and conveyed, the Court finds /

That said Moses Coney died intestate within the present boundaries of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, on or about the ___ day of 18 ~~1908~~ .

That the said Moses Coney was a member and duly enrolled as such of the Muskogee (CREEK) Nation or tribe of Indians and was on the rolls of the Commission ^{Territory now the State of Oklahoma as a full blood member of said} to the Five Civilized Tribes at Muskogee Indian Nation or tribe as No ___ on said Roll ;

That said Moses Coney was an allottee or was entitled to an allotment of the lands of the said Nation or tribe of Creek Indians . That there was selected as the
