I, Bank Colbert, of the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, being first duly sworn, on oath do say that I am the same person as the one who signed the name of Bank Colbert to a rental contract given by Isabell Colbert to Robert Shipman dated September 16th, 1902 and recorded in Book "A" at Page 319 of the records of the Deputy Clerk and ex-officio Recorder of the United States Court at Sapulpa, Indian Territory, now State of Oklahoma. That the said Isabell Colbert's name was in fact Isabelle Barker and not Isabell Colbert. That at the time said rental contract was executed the said Isabelle Barker and Myself were living in the same house together, she being my housekeeper but in no sense my wife; that she was my housekeeper for a period of about seven years but during that time, nor at any time prior nor subsequent thereto, were we ever married. That during the time she acted as my housekeeper she was sometimes referred to as Isabell Colbert and at other times as Isabell Barker and took to signing her name as Isabell Colbert instead of Isabelle Barker, to which inclination I made no immediate objection. That on or about July 1905 I concluded to enter into lawful wedlock with one Arvella Williams and therefore dismissed the said Isabelle Barker as my housekeeper as aforesaid since which time I have known practically nothing of her acts, employment or relations. That on the 16th day of July 1905 I was duly and legally married to the above named Arvella Williams with whom I am now living as my lawful wife at Alsuma, Okla.

That I hereby disavow, relinquish and disclaim unto the said Isabelle Barker any rights, interest or title of any kind or nature whatsoever which I may have acquired, either expressly or by implication by reason of my personal relations with her as above named, in or to any real or personal property which she may now own or may have ever owned.
