DECLARATION:-

*vacation of a portion of Cherokee Heights' Second addition to the City of Tulsa*

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That whereas heretofore on the \_\_\_\_ day of February, 1908 one W. O. Dickenson of Tulsa, Oklahoma, being then the owner and proprietor thereof, laid out and caused to be surveyed and platted into lots, blocks, streets, and alleys, as an addition to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, the following described real estate, to-wit: The South One-half of the South-west Quarter of the South-west Quarter of Section Thirty-two (32), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, containing Twenty (20) acres more or less located in Tulsa

County, State of Oklahoma, to be known and designated as Cherokee Heights' Second Addition to the City of Tulsa; and, *whereas on the 14th day of February, 1908 a plat of said addition showing the lots, blocks, streets and alleys therein was duly filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and duly recorded in Book 30 at Page 11, Cherokee Heights' Second Addition*

WHEREAS, Said addition lies wholly without and beyond the corporate limits of said City of Tulsa; and

WHEREAS, The said W. O. Dickenson has heretofore sold and conveyed the aforesaid tract of land to The Cherokee Company, a corporation, and one W. S. Hall of Tulsa, Oklahoma; and,

WHEREAS, The said The Cherokee Company and the said W. S. Hall are now the owners and proprietors of all that portion of said Cherokee Heights' Second Addition, lying West of and adjoining the west line of blocks 1 and 8 in said addition; and,

WHEREAS, The said The Cherokee Company and W. S. Hall, the owners and proprietors thereof, desire to vacate all that portion of the plat of said addition so owned by them as aforesaid and all the lots, blocks, streets and alleys therein:

NOW, THEREFORE, In consideration of the premises the said The Cherokee Company, a corporation, and the said W. S. Hall, the owners and proprietors thereof do by these presents vacate, and do declare to be vacated, all that part or portion of the said Cherokee Heights' Second Addition to the City of Tulsa, and all of the lots, blocks, streets, and alleys therein, lying west of and adjoining the west line of

blocks 1 and 8 in said addition *it being expressly understood that this vacation shall in no wise affect the said blocks 1 and 8 in said addition and the same are hereby expressly reserved from this vacation*
