ORDER APPROVING LEASE.

This matter came on to be heard on this the 14th, day of October, 1908 upon the petition of Frank Futrell, guardian of Jimmie Futrell asking for an order of the court approving and confirming his action in making and executing for and on behalf of said minor, Jimmie Futrell an oil and gas mining lease running to the Ballinger Oil Company, which said lease has been presented to ^{this} the court for approval.

The petitioner appearing in person and by his attorneys, Abbott & Brown, and the court after hearing the testimony of the petitioner and the testimony of the ^{disinterested} witnesses as to the value of the land described in ^{the} this lease for oil and gas mining purposes, and after hearing the argument of counsel, and being duly advised in the premises, finds:

That the allegations contained in said petition are true that the said Frank Futrell is the legally appointed ^{and qualified} guardian of the said minor; that the said minor is of the age of five years and that the said minor is possessed of the following described real estate, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to wit:

The Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter ^{of the southwest quarter} and the South half of the South East Quarter of Section 3, and Lots 1 and 2 of Section 13, all in Township 19, North, Range 11, East.

The court further finds that on the 12th, day of October, 1908, the petitioner for and on behalf of the said minor, Jimmie Futrell, made and executed a certain oil and gas mining lease, embracing the land above described and running to the Ballinger Oil Company, a corporation, under and by virtue of the terms of which said lease, the bonus of said lease is the sum of

Forty Dollars, and the royalty to be paid thereunder is one eighth of the oil and gas produced, and the court further finds that the bonus and royalty are fair and reasonable and are as good as can be obtained, and it would be for the best interest of said minor if the said lease be approved.

WHEREFORE, It is by the Court considered, ordered and adjudged and decreed that the said action of the said Frank Futrell, guardian, in executing said lease for and on behalf of the said minor, Jimmie Futrell, be and the same is hereby approved and the said Frank Futrell, guardian is hereby directed and authorized to deliver the said lease to the said Ballinger Oil Company, upon payment to him, by the said company, said bonus mentioned in said lease.
