The above rental shall be pfaid to the first party, in person, or to the credit of the first party at the City National Bank, Wagoner, Oklahoma, and it is agreed that the completion of such well shall be and operate as a full liquidation of all rent due under under this provision during the remainder of the term of this lease.

The party of the second part shall have the right to use oil, gas and awater produced on said land, free of royalty, for drilling and operating thereon, except water from wells of first party.

When request by the first party the second party shall bury his pipe lines, except steam pipe lines belowplow depth:

No well shall be drilled nearer than two hundred feet to the house or tarn of said premises.

Second party shall pay for damage caused by him to growing crops on said lands.

The paty of the second part shall have the right at any time to remove all machinery and fixtures plazed on said premises, including the right to draw and remove casing.

The part of the second part his successors or assigns, shall have the right at any time after one year, on the payment of one dollar, and all payable obligations then due to the party of the first part, his heirs or assigns, to surrender this lease, if not tested for cannecellation, after which all payments and liabilities thereafter to accrue under and by virtue of its terms shall cease and determine.

All covenants and agreements herein set forth between the parties hereto, shall extend to their successors, heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.
