ORDER OF COURT.

IN THE COUNTY COURT OF MCINTOSH COUNTY AND STATE OF OKLAHOMA.

IN THE MATTER OF THE GUARDIANSHIP OF RUFERT DEPRIEST, A MINOR LEVI CHILDERS (GUARDIAN)
ORDER CONFIRMING AND APPROVING LEASE OF WARDS LAND FOR OIL AND GAS.

On this day Levi Childers, guardian herein, presents for confirmation and approval and oil and gas mining lease executed in triplicate on the 9th, day of October, A. D. 1908, with G. T. Braden of Pittsburg, Pa., lessee, for a term extending from the 9th, day of October 1908, to the 27 day of May, 1918, and so long thereafter as oil and gas is produced therefrom covering the lands of his ward, Rufert Depriest, in Tulsa County, and State of Oklahoma, described as follows/ to wit:

The North East quarter of the South East Quarter and Lots Seven (7) and Eight (8) of Section Thirteen (13) Township Seventeen (17) North and Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian containing One Hundred and Fourteen and Eighty Eight One Hundredths (14.88) acres, more or less.

pursuant to the ^{an} order of this court made on the 5th, day of October, 1908.

And having examined said lease and heard evidence upon the same and it appearing that the guardian is receiving a bonus of ^{two} Two Hundred and Seven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$207.50) for said lease and said bonus is the best that could be obtained/ it further appearing that the lessee herein is a reliable and responsible person; and it further appearing that said lease is for the best interest of the said Ward's estate and is in proper form and covers only the period of said wards minority, and being well and sufficiently advised in the premises:-

It is ordered that the said lease be and the same is hereby ratified, approved and confirmed, and that a certified copy of ^{this} the order be attached to each of the three parts of said lease here and now presented for approval and that one part thereof with such certified copy attached be returned to said Guardian Levi Childers; on² part with certified copy attached delivered to the lessee G. T. Braden of Pittsburg, Pa., the triplicate part to remain on file in this court with the papers in the case.
