ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE (Office of Indian Affairs Received Nov. 26, 1907) File 93245)

WHEREAS, The Secretary of the Interior has heretofore approved an oil and gas mining lease, dated March 19th, 1904, entered into by and between Edward J. Bonacker, lessee, and Samuel W. Brown Jr. Lessor, covering the following described lands in the Creek Nation, Indian Territory:

North East Quarter of Section Twenty two (22), Township Seventeen (17) North, Range Twelve (12) East of Indian Base and Meridian.

Now, Therefore, for and in consideration of One (\$1.00) dollar, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Edward J. Bonacker, the lessee in the above described lease hereby bargains, sells, transfers, assigns and conveys all right, title, interest of the lessee in and to said lease, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior, to Superior Oil & Mining Company of Red Fork I. T. a corporation, incorporated under the laws of the United States, in force in Indian Territory.
