IN THE MATTER OF THE ESTATE OF ROSA WALKER, minor

An order having been made by this court on the 23rd, day of September, A. D., 1908, authorizing L. W. Marks as the Guardian of the property of Rosa Walker, Minor, to sell certain real estate belonging to said estate, and afterwards, to wit, on the 26th, day of October, 1908 having made to this Court, and filed in the office thereof, a return of his proceedings under the said order of sale, and duly returned to this Court an account of sales, verified by affidavit, his return showing the appraisal and sale after due and legal notice in accordance with the order aforesaid; This Court having examined the said returns, and having in open Court also examined all the orders, files and documents herein touching the matter and it appearing to the satisfaction of this Court:
