-----: ORDER APPROVING DEED :-----

IN the matter of the estate of
Hitchete Frank, Deceased .

On this 10th day of September 1908 is presented to this Court the petition of William ~~FRANK~~, Menene Grayson (Nee Frank) and Mary Grayson (nee Frank) heretofore filed herein, praying the court to approve a deed of conveyance dated September 10 1908 , duly acknowledged, and conveying to S.F. Jones and M.B.Shutts, at and for the cash price of and consideration of Sixteen Hundred Dollars (\$ 1600.000 all the right, title interest and estate of the said William Frank, Menene Grayson and Mary Grayson, heirs at law of Hitchete Frank, deceased , in and to the following described lands, to-wit :

The southwest quarter (S W 1/4) of the Northwest quarter (N W 1/4) and Lots Two (2) Three (3) and Four (4) of Section Two (2) and the southeast quarter (S E 1/4) of the Northwest quarter (N W 1/4) of Section Two (2) and the east half (E 1/2) of the East half (E 1/2) of the southeast (S E) ten (10) acres of Lot One (1) of Section Three (3) all in Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Ten (10) East containing in all one hundred and fifty eight and 94/100 (158.94) acres of land , more or less .

And the court having heard the evidence find that said William Frank Menene Grayson and Mary Garyson are duly enrolled citizens of the full-blood of the Creek Nation; that the above and foregoing lands were duly allotted by the Commission of the Five Civilized Tribes of Indian to Hitchete Frank, the father of said petitioners; that said Hitchete Frank departed this life on or about the ___ day of ___ 19 ; that said William Frank, Menene Grayson and Mary Grayson as the only surviving children and heirs at law of the said Hitchete Frank , deceased, inherited the above described lands; that said sum of sixteen hundred Dollars (\$ 1600.000) is a fair price and
