It is, therefore, by the Court, considered, ordered and adjudged that the said warranty ~~deeds~~ executed by the said William Frank, Menene Grayson and Mary Grayson on the 10th day of September 1908, conveying to the said S.F.Jones and M.B.Shutts all the ~~right, title, interest and estate inherited in and to the above described lands, be and~~ ^{by the said William Frank Menene Grayson and Mary Grayson} the same hereby is in all things confirmed, ratified and approved, and that said S.F.Jones and M.B.Shutts pay the costs of this proceeding.
