This Indenture, Made this third day of February in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and nine (1909), between George W. Tuttle and Mary E. Tuttle, his wife, of the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and W. E. Dunaway of the second part.

WITNESSETH, that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Mortgage to the said party of the second part or assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Tulsa in the State of Oklahoma, described as follows, to-wit: The southerly forty feet of the northerly 1/2 of Lot 111 (5) in Block One Hundred eighty three (183) in City of Tulsa, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point on the westerly line of said lot just ten feet southerly from the northwesterly corner of said lot, thence easterly parallel with northerly line of said lot one hundred forty feet to the alley; thence at right angles southerly along the easterly line of said lot forty feet; thence at right angles easterly, parallel with the northerly line of said lot one hundred forty feet to the westerly line of said lot; thence northerly along the westerly line of said lot to place of commencement.

And it is hereby mutually agreed that in case the party of the second part or its assigns, should hereafter appear in any of the land departments or offices of the general Government, or in any court, in order to preserve or protect the title hereinbefore warranted, all costs and expenditures made in that behalf shall be added to the amounts hereby secured and shall bear interest at the same rate, with the appurtenances, rents, issues and profits and all the estate, title and interest of said parties of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are

the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, and will Warrant and defend the title to the same, and that the same is free and clear of all incumbrances of whatsoever kind except a certain mortgage for \$ 1500 given to THE DEMING INVESTMENT COMPANY.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Three Hundred

Dollars, payable as follows, to-wit:

at the office of THE DEMING INVESTMENT COMPANY, Oswego, Kansas, according to the terms of 4 certain promissory notes of this day executed and delivered by the said parties of the first part to the said party of the second part; and this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof or interest thereon when due, or the taxes, or if any installment of principal or interest of any mortgage or lien prior to this are not paid when the same are due and payable, or if the insurance is not kept in force thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for said party of the second part, or assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not, at the option of the party of the second part, its successors or assigns, and out of all the moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount due for principal and interest, taxes and penalties thereon, and interest on delinquent taxes at the rate fixed by law, together with the costs and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand to the said parties of the first part their heirs or assigns.

And said mortgagors further expressly agree that in case of foreclosure of this mortgage, and as often as any proceedings shall be taken to foreclose the same, as herein provided, the mortgagors will pay to said plaintiff fifty dollars as a reasonable attorney's or solicitor's fee therefor, in addition to all other legal costs and statutory fees, said fee to be due and payable upon the filing of petition for foreclosure and the same shall be a further charge and lien upon the said premises described in this mortgage, and the amount thereof shall be recovered in said foreclosure suit and included in any judgment or decree rendered in any action as aforesaid, and collected and the lien hereof enforced in the same manner as the principal debt hereby secured. It is expressly stipulated that upon default herein suit to foreclose this mortgage may be brought in county where real estate mortgaged is situated regardless of residence of mortgagors, or either of them, and all objections to venue of such suit are hereby expressly waived.
