Lot sixteen, Block eighteen in the town Valley, Indian Territory

to have and hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances
thereto belonging or in any wise afftaining, forever.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities therein belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto.

And said party for himself his heirs executors or administrators, does hereby covenant promise and agree
to have and to hold the aforesigned premises o the said
with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents he is lawfully seized in his own right of
and heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and the said
new absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and
for heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said
described premises, with the appurtenances, that the same are free clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from
and heirs, successors and assigns, that he is lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises, that
all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances of what nature
they are free from all incumbrances, that he has good right to sell and convey the same to said
or kind soever, except taxes or other assessments that might be levied, and that he will warrant and forever defend
as aforesaid, and that his heirs and assigns will and successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and de-
fend the same to the said

all and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming onto claim the same,
and heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lands claims and demands of all persons.
