

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH A POWER OF ATTORNEY

THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this 25th day of June 1906, one thousand nine hundred and six, by and between Lucy Brown, unmarried, of Catoosa, Okl., part of the first part, and John S. Bilby, of Broken Arrow, Okl., part of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ninety hundred DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit:

W 1/4 of SW 1/4 Section 22 Township 19 Range 14 East and my undivided interest in
NW 1/4 sec 22 Township 19 Range 14 East

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said John S. Bilby, and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and I, the said Lucy Brown, for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said John S. Bilby, and his heirs, successors and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that said premises are free from all incumbrances, that I have good right to sell and convey the same, and

as aforesaid, and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said John S. Bilby, and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, W. W. Martin, wife of said John S. Bilby, of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands,
