

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 24th day of July one thousand nine hundred and ten
by and between George Tiger, a single freeborn man 25 years old of
Bugge, D. I. part of of the first part, and John Fields
of Tulsa, D. I. party of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That ~~the~~ the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of
Sixteen Hundred -- (1600) DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,
do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the
Muskogee (Creek) Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

East Half (1/2) of the North East Quarter (1/4) and the South West Quarter (1/4) of the North East
Quarter (1/4) of Section Nineteen (19) Township Nineteen, (19) North, Range Fourteen (14) East,
Containing One Hundred and Twenty (120) Acres, more or less according to the Government Survey
thereof

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereon to be having or in anywise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforegranted premises to the said John Fields
and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and I the said George Tiger
for my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said John Fields
and his heirs, successors and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted premises; that
they are free from all incumbrances; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to said
John Fields as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and de-
fend the same to the said John Fields
and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, John Fields of the for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby re-
lease and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
