WOMEN RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER

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THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 3rd day of November one thousand nine hundred and six

of Indian, Ind. Ter. part of of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part is of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of  
Twenty one Hundred & DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,  
do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part of of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the  
Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot number sixteen in Block number forty-two in the town of Broken Arrow Creek Nation  
Indian Territory

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforegranted premises to the said G. W. Blakey  
and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and we the said Lettie Walker and R. A. Walker  
for ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said G. W. Blakey  
and his heirs, successors and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted premises; that  
they are free from all incumbrances; that we have good right to sell and convey the same to said G. W. Blakey  
as aforesaid; and that we will and our successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and de-  
fend the same to the said G. W. Blakey  
and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Lettie Walker of Broken Arrow Ind. Ter.  
wife of said R. A. Walker, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby re-  
lease and relinquish unto the said part of of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
