THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 5 day of November, one thousand nine hundred and six, by and between Ruth Phillips & Allen Phillips,

of Cherokee, Ind. Ia., party of the first part, and Thomas J. Mahone,

of Cherokee, Ind. Ia., party of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred (\$800.00) and no less

DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do and hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Cherokee Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit:

8th of NWth of SEth of Sec. (9) Nine Township, twenty (20) Range Fourteen (14) containing twenty acres and the
1/4 of 1/4 of Sec. 4 T20, R14E, and NWth of NWth of SEth Sec. 9, T20, R14E making a total of 10 acres, Cherokee
Nation, Ind. Ia.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said Thomas J. Mahone,

and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and to the said Ruth Phillips & Allen Phillips

for themselves and their heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Thomas J. Mahone
that they recognize, own and affirm themselves citizens of the Cherokee Nation, and not of Indian Territory, in respect
and to their heirs, successors and assigns, that they are lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that

they are free from all incumbrances; that they have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Thomas J. Mahone

as aforesaid; and that they will and may successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and de-

send the same to the said Thomas J. Mahone

and to their heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Allen Phillips,

of Cherokee, Ind. Ia.

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
