

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 19th day of November, one thousand nine hundred and six, by and between Henry Shates, unmarried and of full age of 21 years, of Muskogee, Okla., part of the first part, and The Mutual Land & Investment Company of Muskogee, Okla., part of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and no. 00

DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm to the said part of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee (Creek) Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The North half of the north east quarter of the northeast quarter of section nineteen (19), township twenty-one (21) North, Range thirteen (13) East of the Indian Meridian,

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said The Mutual Land & Investment Company and its heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and to the said Henry Shates for ever and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said The Mutual Land & Investment Company and its heirs, successors and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free from all incumbrances; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to said The Mutual Land & Investment Company aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said The Mutual Land & Investment Company and its heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And, in consideration of the sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
