GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH ATTACHMENT OF SCHEDULE

**THIS INDENTURE**, Made and entered into this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of January, one thousand nine hundred and seven, by and between Rina Jones, nee Mcintosh, and Sam Jones, her husband, of Tallahassee, Ind. Ter., parties of the first part, and P. C. Heckman, of Muskogee, Ind. Ter., party of the second part;

**WITNESSETH**, That that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand and other good and valuable considerations, DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee ( Creek ) Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit:

The West half of the Southeast Quarter, and the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter, of Section Seven (7), Township Eighteen (18) North and Range Fourteen (14) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing 120 acres more or less according to the official survey thereof.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said P. C. Heckman and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and in the said Rina Jones, nee Mcintosh, and Sam Jones, her husband, for ever and his heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said P. C. Heckman, and his heirs, successors and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free from all incumbrance, that we have good right to sell and convey the same to said P. C. Heckman, the aforesaid; and that we will and our successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said P. C. Heckman and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Rina Jones, nee Mcintosh, wife of said Sam Jones, of Tallahassee, Ind. Ter., for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
